Open Volunteer Position

The Grant Writer will be instrumental in helping Bike Buckeye Lake pursue funding opportunities and will be responsible for writing and submitting proposals in response to Request For Proposals.

Responsibilities include:

- Be familiar with Bike Buckeye Lake's goals and financial needs
- Pursue potential funding sources
- Maintain a calendar or pipeline of funding opportunities to anticipate and meet application deadlines
- Compile required information, compose and submit proposals by deadline
- Keep records and track proposals
- If a grant-making organization requests additional information, the grant writer is to supply the missing items
- Stay current on grant writing best practices and what is effective
- Participate in grant-making organization meetings and/or conference calls as needed
- Attend regular Board of Directors meetings, and report on the work of the Committee

- Ability to meet deadlines
